The 19-day Group Training Programme on 'Role of Metrology in Quality Management and Quality Improvement' was arranged at the National Physical Laboratory (NPL), New Delhi under the auspices of the Commonwealth – India Metrology Centre (CIMET) during May 23 to June 10, 1994 and was co-sponsored by the Centre under its NAM Metrology Programme. A total number of 28 participants, besides those from India, attended the event. Participants of the Commonwealth Countries which are also the members of the NAM S&T Centre, viz. Cyprus, Tanzania, Uganda, Zambia and Zimbabwe, were funded by the Commonwealth Fund for Technical Cooperation. The Centre sponsored 4 candidates from its non-Commonwealth member countries. These participants were, respectively from Indonesia (Mr. Achmad Sobirman of Puslitbang KIM-LIPI), Nepal (Mr. Hira Bahadur Nakarmi of the Nepal Bureau of Standards and Metrology and Prof. Jagadiswar Man Pradhan) and Vietnam (Ms. Do Thi Tinh of National Metrology Centre). 40 resource persons delivered their talks during the training programme. Some standards brought by Nepalese scientists were also calibrated at NPL against primary standards.
